





Welcome to Wareham Forest Tourist Park

We hope the following information will make your stay with us an enjoyable and safe experience. Please do not hesitate to ask if we can be of assistance. The Park is a relaxed, quiet family park located within the Wareham Forest, and caters for couples and families on holiday. We ask that our guests follow the Country and Caravan Codes, as well as the guidance set out below and displayed around the Park, to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable stay with us.

DAVID BELLAMY GOLD CONSERVATION AWARD: We are very proud to be recognised for our conservation awareness within the countryside. Living with nature brings great rewards, but must also be respected for the natural hazards it can create. For your own enjoyment and safety, we ask that great care is taken within our natural environment of uneven grounds, streams and woodlands, and would also point out that parents remain responsible for, and need to supervise their children at all times so that they are not a nuisance or danger to themselves or others. At night we operate a low light pollution policy, and advise everyone to use torches when moving around after dark. We are continually upgrading the landscaping, and apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

RECYCLING: Our recycling centre is located between Reception and the adjacent Toilet Block and is open from 8.30am to 10pm. We are able to recycle newspapers and magazines, plastic bottles, cardboard, cans and glass.

QUIET HOURS & NOISE: Please show consideration for other guests at all times. During the hours of 11.00pm and 7.00am the barriers are locked and no access is available. Please leave your vehicles in the late arrivals area if you need to use them to go off site during this time or arrive back after 11pm. In emergency situations only please use the intercoms, located by the barriers and reception door, to contact the Duty Warden. We also ask that between these hours all noise on the Park is kept to an absolute minimum, no flags/windsocks are flown and no vehicle movements are allowed.

USE OF VEHICLES: Please do not use vehicles unnecessarily around the Park, and always, always observe the 5mph speed limit. We take this very seriously and do not tolerate speeding for any reason, because of the danger to others. Commercial vehicles are not allowed except by written prior arrangement.

FIRES / BARBEQUES: Please do not light fires due to the obvious dangers in a forest. Proprietary barbecues are allowed so long as they are off the

ground, and using gas or charcoal only. Please only use your barbecue outdoors, and do not use any wood, pine needles or cones from the Forest. We do ask that all barbecues be extinguished by 10:30pm at the very latest.

DOGS / PETS: Dogs are most welcome on the Park, but we do ask that they are kept on a lead, and that you clear up after them. There is an enclosed dog walking field, many dog walks around the Park and in the Wareham Forest and doggy bins are provided. Please do not take your pets into any buildings or leave them unattended on the park when you go out.

PLAY AREA & BALL GAMES: Please use our large Play Area by Late Arrivals for all games and activities, especially ball games, to avoid disturbing other guests and damaging property. The Play Area closes at dusk.

OPENING HOURS: For reception, shop and swimming pool opening hours, please see the notices in our information room and in both toilet blocks.

RECEPTION: We have post facilities, Tourist Information, and messages on the notice board. There is an intercom to the right of the door for essential out of hours service. Please only use this in an absolute emergency between 9:00pm and 8:30am. There is a BT Payphone located adjacent to the reception building, with useful local and Emergency phone numbers.

SHOP: We have a good range of the basics, off licence, and some caravan/camping accessories. We offer a freezer pack exchange service, and Calor & Camping Gas exchange bottles are also available.

SWIMMING POOL: Please read the Rules displayed in the Pool area. Your children remain your responsibility, and must always be personally accompanied in the Pool area by a parent or responsible guardian.

PITCHES: Please park considerately on your pitch in accordance with the site plan to give maximum space for everyone. We do not allow large windbreaks, and request you keep the pitch tidy. Please vacate the pitch by 11am on the day of departure to allow time to prepare for the next arrivals. Please note all barrier codes disable automatically at this time.
